Quinn Andreas joined RCAC in 2019 as part of the Environmental Finance Center Region 10 Community and Environmental Services team. He provides technical, managerial and financial (TMF) assistance to small, disadvantaged community water and wastewater systems, primarily those serving systems owned and operated by Tribal entities. Mr. Andreas conducts Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulated sanitary surveys, provides technical assistance to systems to improve regulatory compliance, conducts capacity assessments, and assists seasonal water systems. Mr. Andreas also provides private well assessments.

Before joining RCAC, Mr. Andreas spent 10 years working as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) in Idaho and Oregon. He was responsible for an on-site sewage regulatory program, which included conducting site evaluations, permit issuance, and code enforcement. Prior environmental health work included conducting surveys and monitoring public drinking water systems for compliance with Oregon Administrative Rules, and conducting inspections on licensed facilities such as restaurants, pools, motels, recreation parks, organizational camps, daycares, school kitchens, and Job Corps.
