**What:** Tour of the Tri-City Water Resource Recovery Facility, operated by Clackamas Water Environment Services (WES).

**When:** August 30, 2023. Meet at 11am for lunch. Tour will begin at 11:30am and will finish by approximately 1:00pm.

**Where:** 15941 S Agnes Ave, Oregon City, OR 97045. Meet at the administration building with the red roof.

**Who:** Tour is hosted by PNCWA's Lower Columbia Section and will be led by WES staff.

**Tour details:** The Tri-City WRRF is a regional treatment plant that serves customers in Gladstone, Happy Valley, Milwaukie, Oregon City, West Linn and unincorporated Clackamas County. The plant includes a Membrane Bioreactor Process (MBR) and a new 1.3-million-gallon anaerobic digester which creates 50% of the energy needed to run the facility. On average, the Tri-City facility processes 9.94 million gallons per day.
