

Adam Bjornstedt, P.E., Chief Engineer at Clackamas River Water

Since 2008, Adam has served in various engineering roles at CRW, planning and managing a wide array of capital improvement projects with the water treatment plant and distribution system. As Chief Engineer since 2018, he managed completion of the District's Water System Master Plan, oversaw the District's treatment facility master plan, developed CRW's current capital planning strategy, and led a task force on infrastructure and emergency preparedness as part of CRW's strategic plan. Adam manages the System Operations department which oversees planning, design, construction, and maintenance of the distribution system.

Adam received his undergraduate degree in Environmental Engineering from Oregon State University. Prior to joining CRW, he served with the Peace Corps in Jamaica as an environmental educator; then worked with the Indian Health Service as a field engineer, program manager, and district engineer on projects that provided first-time water and wastewater service to Native American homes. Adam is an Oregon licensed Professional Engineer.
