COURSE TITLE

Advanced HAZWOPER Awareness (MOD #2)

COURSE DURATION

2 Hours

OVERVIEW

Employers are required to develop and implement Hazardous Waste Operations (HAZWOPER) training to inform workers (including contractors and subcontractors) performing hazardous waste operations to the level and degree of exposure they are likely to encounter. Training must be conducted initially and annually thereafter.

PREREQUISITES

No prior knowledge is required.

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVES

After successfully completing this course, you will be able to:

- Describe the different forms of hazard communication
- Identify the different parts of a label required by OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard, the DOT, NFPA 704, HMIS, and other systems of labeling hazardous chemicals
- Recall the format of a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) and what information it provides
- Explain the purpose of the North American Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG)
