COURSE TITLE

Advanced HAZWOPER Awareness (MOD #4)

COURSE DURATION

2 Hours

OVERVIEW

Employers are required to develop and implement Hazardous Waste Operations (HAZWOPER) training to inform workers (including contractors and subcontractors) performing hazardous waste operations to the level and degree of exposure they are likely to encounter. Training must be conducted initially and annually thereafter.

PREREQUISITES

No prior knowledge is required.

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVES

After successfully completing this course, you will be able to:

- Identify the elements of a successful pollution-prevention program
- Explain the contents and purpose of a Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest
- Describe how to properly respond to a hazardous materials spill
- Describe the different emergency responder roles, in particular the role of the first responder at the awareness level
- Relate details of the five hazardous waste site operations that would require response from trained first responders
- Explain the Incident Command System and the different members of which it is comprised

COURSE OUTLINE

- The Incident Command System (ICS) – 30 minutes
- Conclusion - 5 minutes
