

## **Hybrid Oregon Spill Workshop & Tabletop Exercise**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), and Oregon Department of Emergency Management (ODEM) are hosting a free one-day <a href="https://example.com/hybrid">hybrid</a> Oregon Spill Response Workshop and Tabletop Exercise. The intent of the event is to assist drinking water suppliers, industry owners (e.g., aboveground storage tank and pipeline owners), local emergency responders, and state and federal agencies to better prepare for a spill to a river or lake that supplies drinking water. The event will include:

- Engagement with industry stakeholders and other water providers, through guest speaker roles.
- Participation by Federal, State, and Local response partners.
- Tools and resources presentations, for example developing Emergency/Geographic Response Plans.
- A half-day tabletop exercise facilitated by EPA contractors utilizing a real-world, location-specific spill scenario that participants will use to simulate a response.

The EPA contractor team will apply for CEUs for Oregon drinking water operator licenses.

The planning team encourages participants to attend the event in person to best participate in the half-day tabletop exercise, but participants have the option to attend virtually if necessary.
