City of Newberg Wastewater Treatment Plant Tour

Where: 2301 NE Wynooski Rd, Newberg, OR 97132

Who: The tour is hosted by the City of Newberg, the Lower Columbia Section of PNCWA, the PNCWA Biosolids Committee, and Keller Associates, Inc.. The tour will be led the City Newberg WWTP Staff.

Tour Details:

The City of Newberg operates a 4 MGD oxidation ditch wastewater treatment plant, built in 1987, with significant upgrades occurring between 2009-2016. During 2023, the plant treated 1.29 billion gallons of raw wastewater. In addition, 600 dry tons of Class A biosolids were recovered and turned into compost that be sold and freely land applied.

The event will begin at 12:00 pm with lunch and a presentation by Keller Associates, Inc. on biosolids handling and composting equipment and processing. At 1:00 pm, the Newberg WWTP staff will then lead the group around the treatment plant, particularly focusing on the biosolids handling process and the in-vessel composter.

The presentation will be conducted by Eric Roundy and Peter Olsen of Keller Associates, Inc.. The tour will be led by Andrew Shepherd, Travis Hyder, and Mike Fischer with the Newberg WWTP.
