Information about the Facility

The City of Coburg has a population of around 1,500 people. We also have a very large industrial area. We operate a small GE MBR (Membrane Bio Reactor) Treatment System coupled with a STEP (Septic tank effluent pumping) Collection system with around 650 connections. The City of Coburg owns and maintains each STEP system site. Our flows into the treatment plan average around 1.65 MGD. We pride ourselves on how we maintain the system and how we are almost 100% removal on CBOD and TSS every month since the plant was put into operation in 2013. Also, very rarely do we see any Ammonia or E. coli.
