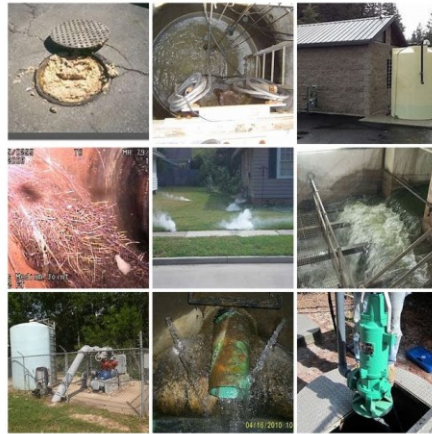


Collection Operator 1 & 2 Review & Exam Prep Workshop
