

# Ready, Set, Maintain: Oregon’s New O&M Rules Explained

## Synopsis

This training, hosted by the O&M Task Force, provides a clear overview of Oregon’s updated Onsite Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Program rules. Participants will learn about the purpose of the program, the distinct roles and responsibilities of property owners, maintenance providers, and local onsite agents, and the key rule changes affecting the O&M program. The course will cover new requirements for service contracts, reporting, and notifications, as well as compliance expectations and enforcement updates. By the end of the training, attendees will understand how the revised rules work together to ensure consistent system maintenance and better environmental protection statewide.
