ICS 300 The training and resources provided assist personnel who require advanced application of the ICS. Topics include:

- How the National Incident Management System (NIMS) Command and Management component supports the management of expanding incidents
- The incident/event management process for supervisors and expanding incidents as prescribed by the Incident Command System (ICS).
- Implementing the incident management process at a simulated incident.
- Developing an Incident Action Plan (IAP) for a simulated incident.

ICS 400 Command System (ICS). The course benefits any person who has a responsibility to function in a command post managing an expanding incident. The course builds upon information covered in the ICS-100, ICS-200, and ICS-300 courses and explains the roles and responsibilities of local, county, state, and federal agencies involved in managing an expanding incident. Topics include:

- Special management challenges for major incidents/events
- Area Command
- Multi-Agency Coordination Systems (MACS)
