

CEU Evaluation Request

Class: SPIRE Emergency Response Trailer set up, run and take down.

Date: ongoing class

Summary: This class is based around the emergency response trailer owned by the Oregon Department of Emergency Management (EOM) and created through their State Preparedness and Incident Response Equipment (SPIRE) program. The class will cover how to deploy the water filtration trailer, run it, and put it back into storage mode.

Hour 1: Introductions, and an overview of what the trailer is, where they are housed and the general types of equipment and technology it utilizes. A walk through and check list of all things that will be needed.

Hour 2: Deploying the trailer. This hour will cover how to physically set the trailer up, turn it on and run it. Review the checklist to be gone through and operations to produce filtered water.

Hour 3: Shutting the trailer down, draining it and packing things away for storage. As this trailer sits a majority of the time not in use. An emphasis will be made in this hour on long-term storage and maintenance. Summary and closing.
