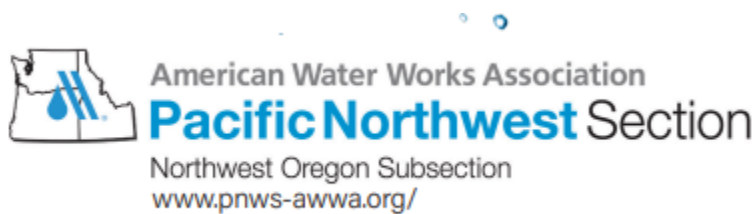

Keeping Track of Attendance:
