Introduction & General Description:

- The Insider Threat Mitigation Webinar, hosted by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), provides drinking water and wastewater systems with information regarding potential threats posed by insiders. Insiders are individuals with authorized access to a facility, such as current or former employees, contractors, or other trusted partners, who may intentionally or inadvertently compromise system operations. This webinar will examine the potential consequences of insider actions, discuss practical and cost-effective strategies to mitigate associated risks, and highlight tools and resources available at no cost from EPA and CISA to support utilities in strengthening their security posture and operational resilience.

- Audiences will be able to understand and identify insider threat risks, behaviors, and consequences, and learn the progression model to detect and mitigate insider threats before incidents occur. Audiences will also be to understand the key components of a proactive Insider Threat Mitigation Program tailored to organizational needs.
