Oregon Water Code History



- 1859: Oregon Statehood
- 1800s-1909: Common law riparianism & prior appropriation rights

- See, e.g. Williams v. Altnow, 51 Or. 275 (1908)

- 1909: Oregon adopts surface water code
- 1955: Oregon adopts groundwater code

The constitution of Oregon contains no provisions directly relating to the diversion and use of water from public streams. No administrative machinery for distributing public waters to those entitled thereto, was available until the adoption of what is commonly called the "Water Code," on February 24, 1909.



Oregon's 1909 Water Rights Act

Public ownership

- All water within state from all sources of water supply belongs to public. ORS 537.110
- Right of appropriation; vested rights protected
 - Subject to existing rights...all waters... may be appropriated for beneficial use, as provided in the Water Rights Act & not otherwise; but nothing ...shall be so construed to take away or impair vested right of any person to any water or use of any water. ORS 537.120

Nevada Water Code History

- 1864: Nevada Statehood
 - Prior appropriation only (except 1872-1885)
 - See Jones v. Adams, 19 Nev. 78 (1885) (overruling Vansickle v. Haines, 7 Nev. 249 (1872))
- 1890s: Adjudications of common law rights
- 1903: Nevada State Engineer is created
 - Created in response to Newlands Project
- 1905: Surface Water
- 1913: Comprehensive Water Code
 - Abandonment, rotation, vested right principles
- 1939: Groundwater added to Code

Nevada's Water Code

- Public Ownership
 - Water of all sources... within boundaries of the State whether above or beneath the surface of the ground, belongs to the public

- NRS 533.025

Vested Rights Protected

Nothing...shall impair the vested right of any person to the use of water, nor shall the right of any person to take and use water be impaired or affected by...this chapter where appropriations have been initiated in accordance with law prior to March 22, 1913
 NRS 533.085

Pre-Code vs Post-Code

- Pre-Code Water Rights (Vested):
 - Established under common law rules
 - Not necessarily recorded
 - Not enforceable
 - Confirmed via adjudication of water rights



- Established under water codes
- State agency maintains records & enforces
- Obtained via permitting process

Adjudications (Pre-Code Process)

Court Directed Process w/ Agency Assistance

 Adjudications necessary to confirm existence of precode rights & place them in priority with later acquired rights of use

OR - Initiation of Adjudication

By water users or OWRD:

ORS 539.021

- (1) Water Resources Director upon motion of director or, in discretion of director, upon receipt of petition from one or more appropriators of surface water from any natural watercourse shall make a determination of the relative rights of various claimants to waters of that watercourse
- (2) If action <u>brought in circuit court</u> for determination of rights to use of water, the case may, in the discretion of the court, be transferred to the director for determination as provided in this chapter

OR – Process w/ Agency Assistance

- Notification of potential vested water right holders
- Claims filed
- Field Investigations
- OWRD compiles preliminary order of determination
- Protests Filed
- OWRD conducts hearings on claims/protests
- OWRD submits determinations & proposed decree to circuit court
- Exceptions, amendments & Corrections Filed
- Decree issued by circuit court
- Appeals

NV - Initiation of Adjudication

Initiated by water users <u>or</u> State Engineer: –NRS 533.087

- (1) Upon <u>petition to State Engineer</u>, signed by one or more water users of any stream or stream system, requesting determination of relative rights of various claimants to waters thereof, State Engineer shall. . . enter an order granting petition & shall make proper arrangements to proceed with such determination
- (2) State Engineer shall, in the absence of such a petition requesting determination of relative rights, <u>enter an order for</u> <u>determination</u> of relative rights to the use of water of any stream selected by State Engineer. . .

NV - Process

- PRELIMINARY ORDER OF DETERMINATION Notification to potential vested users
- Vested "Proofs of Appropriation" filed
- Field Investigations
- NDWR prepares preliminary order of determination

IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE ENGINEER

OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

- **Objections filed**
- NDWR holds objection hearings
- NDWR prepares order of determination • - Filed with district court, akin to a complaint
- May file exceptions to order of determination, amendments & corrections
- Court prepares findings of fact, judicial decree
- Appeals

Federalism Fun Fact!

- Federal/reserved water rights do not need to be claimed (sovereign immunity)
- McCarren Amendment (1952)
 - US waives sovereign immunity for water issues
 - Tribal & other Fed. Claims must be filed in state-law adjudications if <u>noticed</u> as McCarren proceeding
