

Obtaining Water Rights on Federal Land

Taylor Grazing Act

Expressly recognizes ranchers can obtain water rights on federal land

Prior Appropriation Doctrine:

- Predecessor in Interest
- Use dates *prior* to federal reservation of land

Winters Doctrine:

- Water reserved for purpose of reservation
- Example:
 - Water reserved prior to 1976 under the Stock Raising Homestead Act



Acquisition Under State Law

- Two Methods:
 - Pre-Code Methods
 - Post Code Methods
- Method determined by year right originated
 - Was is before or after enactment of water code?

Stockwater in Nevada

Acquisition

- On Public Land
 - Applicant must have legal right to place livestock on public land <u>NRS 533.503</u>
- On Public and Private Land
 - Same manner as right to use for any beneficial purpose <u>NRS 533.490(1)</u>
 - Pre-Code Right: Vested/Adjudication
 - Post Code Right: Application
- Pre-Code Rights
 - Adjudication <u>NRS 533.493</u>
 - Vested stock water rights recognized

Stockwater in Nevada Cont.

- Post Code Rights
 - Duty <u>NRS 533.490(2)</u>
 - Use measured by number of head
 - Proof of Use <u>NRS 533.492</u>
 - Public Land: Statement of Priority or License
 - Private Land: Affidavit or Record of Livestock



- Priority on Public Land NRS 533.495
 - Grazers protected from subsequent stockwater appropriations



Stockwater in Idaho

- Water must be for beneficial use Idaho Code • 42-101
 - "stockwater rights" are water rights for the beneficial use of watering livestock Idaho Code 42-502
 - Acquisition
 - Pre-Code: Idaho Code 42-229
 - Adjudication <u>Idaho Code Title 42, Chapter 14</u>
 - Post Code:
 - Application, permit and license procedure <u>Idaho Code</u> 42-103/Idaho Code Title 42, Chapter 2



Stockwater in Idaho Cont.

- Instream Stockwater <u>Idaho Code 42-113</u>
 - Cattle drinking from stream
 - Permit may be issued, but not required
 - Treated same as other water rights
 - May divert water from stream



- Stockwater on Public Land <u>Idaho Code 42-501(1)</u>
 - Water Right held by the grazing permittee

Stockwater in Oregon Cont.

- Post Code Acquisition
 - Any nonexempt use must go through application for permit process <u>ORS</u> <u>537.130</u>/ <u>ORS 537.615</u>
 - Application <u>ORS 537.140/ORS 537.620</u>
 - Permit <u>ORS 537.211/ORS 537.625</u>
 - Perfection
 - Certificate <u>ORS 537.250</u>/ <u>ORS 537.700</u>
- Preference over other uses <u>ORS</u> <u>536.310(12)</u>
- Some stockwater uses are exempt

Stockwater Exemptions

- Nevada NRS 534.180/NRS 534.013
 - Domestic Exemption 2.5 acre-feet annually
 - "domestic purposes" include watering livestock
- Idaho Idaho Code 42-227/Idaho Code 42-111 – Domestic Exemption
 - 13,000 gallons/day for livestock, homes, garden

• Oregon

- Surface water exemption ORS 537.141(1)(f)
- Groundwater exemption ORS 537.545(1)(a)

United States' Ownership of Stockwater Rights

- Apply State Law for:
 - Acquisition
 - Perfection
 - Maintenance
 - Administration
- Not all states allow the Federal Government to hold stockwater rights





Where can the Federal Government Hold a Stockwater Right?

 No, 2013 State Engineer directed BLM <u>not</u> to file new applications for stockwater on public lands

- 2017 Senate Bill 111 codified 2007 Idaho Supreme Court decision stating federal government <u>cannot</u> appropriate water for livestock unless it owns livestock
- 2020 code revisions leave questions


- Livestock Owner

The Triangle of Interests

"Base Property"

- Land capable to produce crops/forage to support livestock
- Water suitable for consumption by livestock
 - Available & accessible



Oregon Washington Idaho Nevada California Utah International

Ownership of Water as Base Property

- Supports permitted use:
 - Serves as base of operation in grazing district; or
 - Is capable of being used in conjunction with operation utilizing public land outside a grazing district
- Preference attaches to Base Property

Water Developments on Public Lands

- Permanent Water Improvements
 - Title shared by cooperators and US
 - Spring developments, wells, reservoirs, tanks, & pipelines
- Temporary Water Improvements
 - Title held by cooperator
 - *Removable* improvements
 - E.G. Troughs

Range Improvements

- "Range Improvements shall be installed, used, maintained, &/or modified on the public lands, or removed from these lands, in a manner consistent with multiple-use management." 43 CFR 4120.3-1
- Range Improvement authorization:
 - Documents interest in public land improvements
 - Two Kinds:
 - Nonstructural (e.g. seedings)
 - Structural (e.g. water pipelines)
- Type of Authorization:
 - Cooperative Range Improvement Agreement
 - Range Improvement Permit

Cooperative Range Improvement Agreements

- Made with BLM for new permanent range improvements 43 CFR 4120.3-2
 - Improvement owned by U.S. if constructed before March 1984 or after August 1995
 - Permittee compensated if lease cancelled
 - Authorization after August 11, 2006:
 - U.S. & permittee share title in proportion to their contribution
- Some States require cooperative agreement with State Grazing Board/County Commissioner and federal officials
 - e.g. Nevada NRS 568.140

Range Improvement Permit

- After 1995, only authorize construction of temporary range improvements 43 CFR 4120.3-3
- Permittee funds 100% of the construction costs
- Permittee holds title to any improvement constructed before Aug. 1995

1866 Mining Act

 Protected use of water infrastructure used in mining, agriculture, & other purposes prior to withdrawal 43 CFR § 661

FLPMA eradicated laws creating these rights-of-way

Existing rights still recognized

- Must be addressed in Federal Court

Grazing in Wilderness

- Grazing, activities, & necessary facilities allowed only if established prior to wilderness classification
- Motorized access limited
 - Designated by Right-of-way
 - Common Issue: Right-of-way or access road in wrong location




