Synopsis: First, learn the different types of easements, how they are created, and when they might apply. Secondly, the panelists discuss the interpretation of easements and how the interpretation can evolve over time. Further, the presentation outlines common easement issues specifically related to water and protecting water access. Generally, topics will include:

- Basics of property law
 - Estates, deeds, and the “bundle of sticks”
- Types of Easements
 - Express, implied, prescriptive, and “irrevocable licenses”
 - The specific attributes of each kind of easement
 - How you can protect water access to points of diversion, ditches, and pipelines
- Utility easements
- Well sharing agreements
