

Course 1:

This objective of this course is to provide drinking water treatment plant operators with an overview of the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations and what this typically means in practical terms for plant operators. The course covers such essential rules, for example: Surface Water Treatment Rule; Groundwater Rule; Stage 1 and 2 Disinfectant and Disinfection By Product Rule (DBPR); Lead and Copper Rule; Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR); and Nitrate and Arsenic Rule.

- Types of Contaminants: Microbial vs. Chemical
