Breaks are never calculated as part of the available credits for any WEF sessions. 1.0 CEU = 10 Hours of session time -- 1.0 PDH = 1 Hour of session time -- 1.0 Contact Hour = 1 Hour of general contact time

CEU - Continuing Education Unit (Includes CECs, TCHs, TCUs, TUs) -- PDH - Professional Development Hour -- GCHs - General Contact Hour
