High Performance HMI is a design philosophy for HMI's developed in 2008 by the PAS Company. It has recently become the standard graphics design criteria for both Wonderware and Allen Bradley HMI's. In contrast to years of scattered HMI design criteria, this design philosophy represents a holistic approach to SCADA. From the basis that HMI operations, "play a critical role in determining the operator's ability to effectively manage the operation, particularly when faced with abnormal situations," it addresses best practices for an HMI that most effectively can serve operators in those situations and significantly reduce response time. These best practices include, hierarchical design with progressive levels of detail, appropriate use of color (often the most remarked about portion, utilizing gray scale for most graphics and using color to draw operator attention only when needed, and in combination with shapes for those who are color blind), at-a-glance recognition of problems using principles of pattern recognition, grouping of relevant information and contextualizing data into information making effective use of analog indicators, gauges, ranges and appropriately defined and scaled trends. Beyond the best practices of design it also addresses keeping the operator's work area and computer free of other distracting tasks, layout of control room and workstation monitors and equipment, and other factors. The approach also details an amount of care for the friction that is sometimes caused by adapting to change and operator training.




