Description

Successful Funding Application Basics for Oregon will be a 2-hour training on how to develop successful funding strategies and applications in Oregon. Participants will learn about the DUNS and SAM registration process and leave with materials to help them attain these codes in the future. Participants will also learn what makes projects “attractive” to funders by demonstrating sustainability. RCAC will discuss how to demonstrate this to potential funders through reserve contributions and regular rate adjustments to meet future savings goals.
