

The Flagger Certification Course takes 4 hours to complete, Time is set as a minimum from Chemeketa Community college.

This certification is valid for flagging jobs in Oregon, Washington, Montana, and Idaho. The certification card is valid for 3 years.

The course is Instructor led. There is 3 hours of Classroom theory and flagger safety. Then about an hour for the test. Students must receive an 80 percent on the test to pass.

After program completion each trainee will demonstrate by examination:

- A. Knowledge of Oregon Traffic Control Standards...
- B. Understanding of personal protective equipment and equipment requirements for flaggers.
- C. Understanding of proper flagging positions & stations.
- D. Understanding of proper flagging signals.
- E. Understanding of hazards involved in flagging and traffic control.
- F. Ability to set up an effective traffic control on a two-way road using two flaggers.
- G. Ability to set up effective traffic control on a multi-lane road using one flagger.
